The Corn Caucus Project's purpose is to keep corn growers informed and engaged in the 2012 presidential campaign. It outlines both the Republican and Democrats' views on a variety of agricultural topics.

Presidential candidates were asked to answer a survey on questions that relate to the National Corn Growers Association legislative priorities. Topics included in the survey are: ethanol, farm programs, trade, EPA and transportation.

Based on survey responses submitted by the presidential candidates and media tracking, each candidate was scored in regards to corn legislative priorities. If a candidate failed to complete the survey, the committee used published statements, official records or information from the candidate's website to complete the voter guide.









