Dates and Times:

April 14th 2015:

9:00 am: Cotton Co: From Exit 5 (Randlett) on I44 go 1 mile west then north 0.25 mile. Plot west of road.

4:00 pm: Jackson Co: From Altus, go 6 miles west on HWY 62, canola field south of the road.

April 15th 2015:

8:00 am: Canadian Co: From I-40 exit 130 (Banner Rd.) go 0.5 m south to Jensen Rd., then 2.5 m west.

11:30 am: Kingfisher Co: Plot located in field just north of fairgrounds.

5:30 pm: Blaine Co: From Okeene go 4 miles south, then 2 miles west then, 0.5 miles north. Plot west of road.

April 16th 2015:

9:00 am: Major Co: From Hwy 60&58 junction in Fairview, go 1 mile west then 0.5 miles south. Plot west of road. 6:00 pm: Woods Co. Go 3.5 miles north of Dacoma to CR 210 (Garvin), then 2 miles east. Field strips south of road.

April 17th 2015:

9:00 am: Grant Co: From HWY 81&64 north of Enid, go 3 miles west, 2 miles south, 1 mile west. Plot south of road 1:00 pm: Noble Co: From the HWY 15 in Billing, go 5.25 miles south on CR 20. Plot east of road.
